
I enjoy a life of sharing culture with people from all over the world.

Why do we want to start this community?

In the last few years, due to COVID-19, mobility has been restricted and, in contrast, online interaction has flourished. Now that COVID-19 has subsided, people are interacting with each other again, but the future is uncertain, as depending on the political situation in the world, it can be difficult to move around.

Now that everyone has started to interact online, we want to start a community with culture as the subject matter, so that people can interact directly with each other, in the hope that we can preserve and foster cultures around the world and contribute to the happy growth of everyone around the world.

In the past, people have systematically moved around and interacted face-to-face with each other and with different cultures, but we believe that in the future, people from all over the world can directly interact with each other in real-time and cultivate their cultures in an exciting way.

On social networking sites, people are sometimes careful about sending out information, and it is difficult to express their true feelings. I think it's a good idea to create a closed community where people with similar interests can get together to some extent, and create a place where they can interact in a relaxed manner within the community.

Everyone is miraculously born and lives in this world, so I want them to make the best of the life they have been given. Of course, I want to make the best of my life together with everyone else who is living at the same time!

Only I can be the change. But if I walk together with everyone else, I will be happy and joyful. I felt that it was time to start this community.

Why a 'world culture creators community'?

This community is a center (Hub) of wisdom and experience, a gathering of people who, by interacting with each other, naturally realize their own unique way of life, help each other, and move straight ahead. We gather here to share wisdom and experiences, learn, and grow together.
